### STREETLIGHTS POLICY

#### Purpose

The Rural Municipality of St. Andrews aims to provide the highest level of service and the highest quality of infrastructure to its ratepayers. The purpose of this policy is to establish the conditions under which the Municipality will undertake the installation of street lighting.

#### Policy

- 1) Installation of Streetlights shall be as close as possible to the following:
  - 50 metre spacing between streetlights
  - 70 watt to 100 watt bulbs
- 2) One streetlight per Ward may be installed by the Municipality per year at Council's discretion.
- 3) Streetlights shall be installed in subdivisions as per subdivision agreements and Manitoba Hydro guidelines at the expense of the Developer.
- 4) Every effort will be made to ensure that streetlights will be installed as needed and in an equitable fashion throughout the Municipality.
- 5) Requests for streetlights shall be directed to the Municipal Office in writing.
- 6) Complaints should be directed to Manitoba Hydro or the "Lights Out" link listed on the R.M. of St. Andrews website.

#### Procedure

- 1) As soon as possible after a written request is received the Chief Administrative Officer shall contact the Director of Operations and the Councillor for the Ward in which the request came from for his/her recommendation.
- 2) If there is a recommendation to proceed the C.A.O. and/or the Director of Operations shall request from Manitoba Hydro an estimate for installation of the streetlight.
- 3) If there is still a recommendation to proceed after consultation with Manitoba Hydro it shall come before Council at the next Council meeting for resolution.
