

RM OF ST. ANDREWS Summer Employment – Community Service Ambassadors

The RM of St. Andrews <u>www.rmofstandrews.com</u> will be accepting applications from post-secondary students for 2 summer positions located at various locations within the municipality. The job will start in May and end August 30, 2024. The wage is \$17.30-\$18.30/hr (dependent on qualifications) for 35 hrs/wk.

This opportunity will be available through a Manitoba Metis Federation grant and is open to **any applicants of Metis**, **Non-Status**, **or Inuit decent**. Grant requirements specify that applicants must be students between the ages of 15-30 who attended school full-time during the preceding year and who intend to return to school on a full-time basis in fall 2024 (part-time and distance educations students do not qualify).

The students will work as a team and be responsible for performing community service requests in the municipality for not-for-profit organizations/recreation facilities such as maintenance tasks and upkeep of buildings/outdoor green space. They will work as a recreation team member on trail maintenance, grass cutting, yard work and gardening. There will also be work on special projects such as recycling programs, community litter clean-up initiatives, community programs and events, community assessments, and volunteer initiatives. A valid driver's license and vehicle are required to get to different job locations within the municipality. The ability to drive a truck and pull a trailer would be beneficial for these roles.

Application deadline is Friday April 12 at 4:30 pm, however applications will be accepted until positions are filled. Those interested should apply as soon as possible with a cover letter and resume to Teresa at recreation@rmofstandrews.com.
