

EARL GREY AND CLANDEBOYE WASTE DISPOSAL GROUND TIPPING FEE RATES – AMENDED MAY 8, 2023



TIPPING FEE INFORMATION

Prepaid tipping fee punch cards are available to commercial waste haulers, roofing contractors and yard service contractors only. Both waste disposal grounds have debit card machines and accept debit or cheque payment as well as cash. Fees over \$500.00 can be invoiced providing prior arrangements have been made with the office of the Rural Municipality of St. Andrews.

Shingles – Small trailer or ½ ton truck load	\$45.00
Shingles – Tandem/triple axle or large trailer	\$90.00
Carpets (½ ton truck load)	\$20.00

All Freon Containing Appliances

Water coolers, window or household air conditioners, \$20.00 each

Cushioned Chair	\$10.00 each
Mattress or Box Spring	\$15.00 each

All Commercial Refuse Haulers must maintain a business license in accordance with the current Business License By-law, or the hauler will be refused to unload. A copy of the license must be presented to the Landfill Custodian upon unloading. Providing proof of the business license will be required by the Custodians and arrangement for payments previous to any unloading.

- All vehicles must report to the custodian prior to entry and show their Refuse Permit for access to the waste disposal grounds. Only RM residents have access to the waste disposal grounds.
- All loads must be secured so that garbage does not fall off onto roadways and cause a danger to others.
- All household garbage must be bagged in at least a 70LB bag (regular green garbage bag).
- Separate garbage into the following categories: household, burnables, recyclables and compost materials.
- All demolition waste must be sorted (shingles, wood, drywall etc.).
- No plastic bags in the compost pile.
- No scavenging.
